Te Pūkenga is building a national network of integrated learning in Aotearoa New Zealand that better meets the needs of learners, their whānau, employers and the community.

By bringing together on-the-job, on campus and online learning, Te Pūkenga is creating a network that gives learners more choices and flexibility in what, where and how they learn.



Please note our programmes of study are currently under review as part of the reform of vocational education training. The objective is to provide one programme for Te Pūkenga that is portable, consistent, and more closely aligned with the needs of industry. As the review is ongoing, this prospectus is correct at the time of publishing but the courses outlined may change over time.

It's my pleasure to be able to provide an introduction in this 2023 prospectus and welcome you to Te Pūkenga, nei te reo rāhiri e rere atu ana – nau piki mai, nau kake mai ki Te Pūkenga.

In 2020, the government reviewed the vocational education system in Aotearoa New Zealand and made some significant changes for how it would work in the future.

One of those changes was the creation of Te Pūkenga, New Zealand institute of Skills and Technology. The change meant that all of the country's Kura Tini, Institutes of Technology and Polytechnics, such as Whitireia and WelTec, as well as some of the country's Industry Training Organisations which focus on work-based learning such as apprenticeships, will now sit within one organisation – Te Pūkenga.

By bringing these organisations together, it means we can create a national network of on-the-job, on campus and online learning opportunities that give learners more choice and flexibility in what, where and how they learn throughout Aotearoa New Zealand.

For those of you thinking of enroling with Whitireia or WelTec for study in 2023, this means you are going to be enroling with a national organisation and you will receive a qualification from Aotearoa New Zealand's largest education provider, Te Pūkenga.

You'll still be able to study in Wellington or Porirua but you'll have the additional benefits that come from being part of a national network - such as more support, more study options and increased ability to switch between different types of learning if your circumstances change.

A national network means we can plan better for the future needs of Aotearoa. We want to make sure that when you enrol in a programme, you are gaining skills that are needed by Aotearoa and around the world – giving you more job security and ultimately increasing your opportunities for success.

Our transformation is a journey that will take time but one thing is clear, everything we do is centred around our learners and their whānau. We have a relentless focus of equity and we're setting the foundations to deliver to Te Tiriti o Waitangi and its principles, and most importantly to the aspirations of Māori learners, their whānau, and iwi/hapū.

Throughout this prospectus you may notice that a number of programmes are changing.

We are unifying programmes to make sure they are consistent across the country. This means if your circumstances change, you'll be able to continue with your study rather than having to start again It's just one of the ways we are working to make learning fit around life, rather than making life fit around learning.

Whether you're looking to continue with your study or try something fresh, we look forward to you joining Te Pūkenga whānau and being part of this transformational journey with us.

Our stories A MATOU KORERO AKE

As the regional representative for vocational education in the lower North Island, we are proud stewards of our collective whakapapa. Owning our collective histories and aspirations for the future through acknowledging people, place, culture and values.

We would like to thank our iwi partners Ngāti Toa Rangitira (Porirua) and Te Rūnanga o Te Āti Awa (Lower Hutt) for all the hard work they do ensuring relationships with ākonga (students) and community remain strong as we transition into Te Pūkenga.

Whitireia has always been proud of its history. From the beginning, it could be said that Whitireia had a sense of belonging to something older and more ancient than itself, taking on a name that, as Ngāti Toa Rangitira kaumātua Ihakara Arthur described it, was from the ngā atua, the gods. The very role was given to Whitireia, or Parumoana as it was then briefly known, to provide Porirua and the surrounding region options in tertiary education. It was a mandate that facilitated a belief that what began with a historic groundbreaking one cold dawn in 1985 and would continue to grow from strength to strength. WelTec was one of New Zealand's oldest tertiary education institutions and the secondoldest in Wellington. WelTec has changed over the years but has always focused on teaching real skills. For over a century WelTec has provided high-quality education. Even though WelTec has transitioned to Te Pūkenga, the focus remains focus remains on providing ākonga with quality education, connecting in with industry and community.

We have delivery sites throughout the Wellington region which includes the Porirua (Whitireia) campus, Kensington Avenue and Construction Campuses in Petone, Avalon Studios and the Te Auaha and Hospitality sites in the heart of the CBD.

As of 1 September 2022, Whitireia and WelTec have fully transitioned to Te Pūkenga. While we may have been woven into a greater whole, our focus continues to be providing you, our ākonga with quality education, connecting you to industry and setting you up for your chosen career. We offer certificates, diplomas, degrees and postgraduate programmes.

Our delivery sites

A MĀTOU WĀHI WHAKATAKI

We have many delivery sites across the Wellington region, allowing specialised and tailored learning in industry leading facilities.

The Whitireia site in Porirua is the base for most of our Health and Social Services programmes. Located just 20 minutes from Wellington City, and looking out over Te Awarua o Parirua towards Whitireia peak, the Whitireia delivery site is one of New Zealand's most beautiful sites for vocational learning.

The Petone delivery site is located in the vibrant suburb of Petone. The area is full of cafés, bars and restaurants as well as being home to the Lighthouse Cinema, Remutaka Cycle Trail and Petone Settlers Museum. The Petone delivery site specialises in teaching business, IT, built environment programmes, engineering trades and hair and beauty salons.


Our Construction site is one of the biggest trades training facilities in Aotearoa. The facility is located on State Highway 2, just minutes from Petone railway station with lots of parking available. Students learn through tailored workshops that develop skills in carpentry, painting, decorating and tiling. The facility opened in 2015 and is only a few minutes' drive from the Kensington Avenue (Petone) delivery site. Our Te Auaha site delivers our Cosmetology, Creative and Performing Arts programmes. Located right in the heart of Wellington City. Situated on the corner of Cuba Street and Dixon Street, it's just around the corner from Wellington's best loved bars, venues restaurants, shops and attractions. Te Auaha facilities include two theatres, 55-seater cinema, exhibition gallery, performance spaces, hair and beauty salons and a barbershop.

Our modern Hospitality site is located on Wellington's famous Cuba Street, just a 15-minute walk from Wellington railway station. Being on Cuba Street means our hospitality and culinary arts students are learning in the thick of the action – a dynamic and constantly changing environment that only the Wellington CBD can provide.

Screen production students study all things film at Avalon studios. Situated in the Hutt Valley students will be taught about the New Zealand film environment, editorial and on-set production processes and scriptwriting, all while working with top-line filming and editing equipment.

No matter what campus ākonga Māori find themselves on, whether it's the Porirua, Petone or CBD campuses, our Māori engagement teams are here to provide support. This approach resonates most deeply with ākonga Māori, giving them the cultural and support frameworks to allow the best possible success in their study journey.

Wai Ora services

We recognise the needs of ākonga Māori. The freshly launched Wai Ora service provides a way to meet the unmet mental health and hauora needs of ākonga Māori and Pacific ākonga. This service is offered on all of our campuses. Ākonga are able to use this service as part of a group, individually, in-person or online.





Where to find us

Our Tamaiti Whāngai engagement advisors and Te Awaruai teams are located on the main Porirua and Petone campuses.

You'll be able to find the majority of the Tamaiti Whāngai team on the ground floor of T Block, in the hub area. There you will be able to walk in, have a hui and ask any question you might have.

For those who have enrolled with WelTec and are studying on the Porirua campus, the Tamaiti Whāngai team also have a space in the trades area, the office can be found at D326, next to the Campus Services area.

Te Awarua is our Ākonga Māori support centre based at the Porirua Whitireia campus. The team from Te Awarua support the success and development of all ākonga Māori studying at Whitireia and provide a range of academic, pastoral, cultural and mentoring support. The team can also offer advocacy internally and externally as required.

Te Awarua is an iwi-led centre and provides active partnerships between Whitireia and Te Rūnanga o Toa Rangatira.

Celebrating Pacific languages and cultures

Each year our institutes celebrate nine Pacific language weeks in partnership with Porirua City Council and local cultural communities. Ākonga across our campus' will enjoy a mix of online, face-to-face activities and food.

Working with communities

Our Pacific team are active members of their communities. They engage in local events and matters of interest, keeping up to date with the needs of the area. Serving students

Having been welcomed through the official pōwhiri and mihi whakatau, Pacific ākonga receive a Turou (welcome) and introduction to the institutes, our staff and their peers. With over 200 ākonga attending a wonderful sense of belonging is created from day one!

Pacific Engagement Advisors work across our Porirua, Petone and CBD campuses. The advisors will be able to help with any study or pastoral related topics.

We have designated spaces on campus for our Pacific learners to come and be amongst peers, get some study done or even talanoa with graduates and tutors. There is the Pasifika Centre in Petone and Ako Ake in Porirua. The advisors will connect ākonga who need further support to local Pacific service organisations.

Celebrating achievement

Falarazzi is the signature event where we celebrate Pacific achievement with our wider community. It recognises not just the students' successes but is the opportunity for the whole family to get involved. Community leaders, government representatives, Pacific diplomats, alongside grandparents, children and partners all attend which gives the celebration a true community feel. It's certainly one of the most colourful events of the year!

Careers support

Flexible learning options

Many of our programmes have options for ākonga to study flexibly, allowing them the freedom to learn and manage other life commitments.

Each programme on our website lists what flexible study options are available. Some programmes have more face-to-face, on-campus delivery than others and many programmes do require on campus learning. Yet there are many options ākonga can use to enable them to achieve study success.

Part-time learning

Programmes that enable part time learning allow ākonga to complete their chosen course of study over a longer time period. This allows learners the flexibility to study while managing other commitments. Depending on the programme, part-time options can include a duration of 1-5 years.

Full-time learning

Full-time study is how many of the programmes are delivered. Ākonga are required to commit the required time studying in order succeed in their study. Full-time learning constitutes on campus study, remote (online) learning or studying as part of a work placement.

Blended learning

Blended learning allows ākonga to study both on-campus and off site, completing online lectures and tutorials. Programmes with blended learning normally require ākonga to come on to campus to complete block courses during set times. The rest of a blended learning programme is taught online, allowing for flexibility in how ākonga can complete their programme.

Short courses

Short courses are an excellent way to learn new skills while not having to commit to full time learning. These courses will be available throughout the year, keep an eye out for them on the website.

Tuapapa FOUNDATIONS FOR SUCCESS

Tūāpapa are short online courses created to help you succeed along your journey. They fill in gaps, help you to build confidence and prepare you for academic success.

Tuāpapa online courses are free, flexible around your needs and provide short, engaging and interactive content across a variety of areas. Currently, we have Tuāpapa courses in:

- Academic Writing (Levels 2-4)
- Academic Research Skills (Levels 3-4)
- The Cardiovascular and Pulmonary System (Level 3)
- The Homeostasis System and Cells (Level 4), and
- The Immune System
- More to Come!

There are also some shorter courses that can help you along your study journey:

- Tools for Study (from Time Management to using tools like Word and Moodle)
- Academic Communication (from APA Referencing to Proofreading and Editing)

It might be recommended for you to enrol in Tūāpapa when you talk with us. You can complete Tūāpapa before you start or alongside your study. You can even prepare yourself for study over the summer break by enrolling in Tūāpapa.

Enjoy the benefits of staying at school while you're learning new skills and achieving school qualifications.

Wellington Trades Academy is the perfect gateway initiative allowing ākonga to learn new skills in a subject you're interested in, allowing you to pathway on to further study.

We partner with local secondary schools to provide programmes that allow you to achieve NCEA Level 2, or in some cases Level 3. This will get you ready for employment or higher-level qualifications and training.

You'll study fees free and be provided with subsidised travel assistance subject to meeting Ministry of Education criteria for eligible students. Courses start at the beginning of each year. Subject areas include:

Whether you're unsure of what programme to study, or how to get started on your learning journey, we have a range of study and support options to help you pathway on to higher learning.

Tasters

We offer Tasters to secondary school students that run ½ day to 1–day. These provide experiences for ākonga in a variety of programmes that we offer.

STAR

Sample a range of courses while still at school. Gain new skills and earn credits towards NCEA.

Completing a STAR course enables you to progress to more advanced options and gives you practical skills to find work.

Māori and Pasifika Trades Training

Māori and Pacific ākonga looking to learn a trade can apply for a Māori and Pasifika Trades Training scholarship to cover full fees and course-related costs.

Māori and Pasifika Trades Training Scholarship students are supported by both Whitireia and WelTec through the Tamaiti Whāngai team.

The Tamaiti Whāngai team will support you with mentoring, goal setting, pastoral and cultural support. You'll have the opportunity to get your drivers license, site safe and first aid certificates. The dedicated Tamaiti Whāngai Job Brokers have close links with employers and industry and will assist you to find an apprenticeship and/or employment.

Study Fees Free NGĀ KAUPAPA AKO KORE UTU

Fees free study eligibility

If you're new to tertiary study, or you've previously done less than six months at tertiary level then you might qualify for a range of fees free study.

In order to qualify for fees free study you need to meet the following requirements:

- be allowed to work and live in New Zealand permanently, or be an Australian or New Zealand resident who has lived here for at least three years
- enrol in an eligible qualification
- not be enrolled in school when your qualification starts, and either;
- have been enrolled at school in 2022, or
- have not previously studied or trained for more than 60 credits (except while you were at school)

Youth Guarantee

Are you 16-19 years old?

Youth Guarantee enables you to train fees free for two years in a range of practical programmes. Complete an introductory programme at level 1 or 2 and then choose from a wider selection of level 3 options.

Youth Guarantee can help cover your fees, course-related costs and travel. This could be ideal if you want to keep learning, but feel school is no longer for you.


